OSRS Suggestion: Addy & Rune Dragons (With lore!)

For years, players have speculated and suggested Adamant and Rune dragons be added. I'd like to make my own suggestion for this, and take you along for the ride. Though my original design was aimed at being a mini-quest along the lines of the Ghostly Robes or unlocking the Abyss, this could easily be fleshed out further and expanded to be a full quest in its own right. Figured it was best to start small, however.

I'll put a link to my spreadsheets for anyone interested in data, as well as take on feedback to refine the concept further with suggestions from the community.

I. The Lore + Accessing the Dragons

Ever since its release, players have speculated as to what lies behind the mysterious **Mithril Door**. Historically, the **Mithril Door** was able to be opened after completing **White Guthix Sleeps**, and using the **Strange Key Teeth** + **Strange Key Loop** found in **Movarin's** hideout on a **Mithril Dragon**. This would create the **Dragonkin Key**, and would open the **Mithril Door**, leading you to where you could light the **Dragon Forge**.

But what lies behind the door for us?



Strange Key



The **Strange Key** is a rare (1/512) secondary drop from **Mithril Dragons**, and a semi-rare (1/128) drop from **Chewed Bone** pyres.

Only one may be obtained at a time and it is untradable.

When picked up, you get a message that the key is cold to the touch, however you can feel a strange heat emitting from it.

If the player takes the key to **Thurgo** (the go-to for anything with smithing...) he'll remark at how an item such as this could even be created, as the outer shell of the key is **Mithril**, however the inner core is **liquid Adamant**. **Thurgo** theorizes that only a talented smith with some magical ability, and a forge hotter than the **Blast Furnace** would be able to produce some an object.

If the player uses the key on the **Mithril Door**, the key will react with the door, melting away the outer core and the liquid **Adamantite** running down into a small keyhole. This will unlock the **Mithril Door**, allowing the player to enter a small room with just a ladder leading down. If the player chooses to climb down, they'll enter a modest cave system.

The **Dragonkin Journal** details the experiments carried out which led to the creation of metal dragons, such as the use of **Dragonkin** magic to infuse dragon eggs with liquid metal.

*Disclaimer: The lore present within OSRS relating to the **Dragonkin** is incredibly sparse, so much of the lore I'd use as reference comes from the **Dragonkin** quests after **White Guthix Sleeps**. This is mostly to help with the OSRS team's decision to not overhaul the previously existing lore, but still allow us to implement these creatures in a way that suits the Old School world.

This also leads to the decision of if we'd want a lore-rich, full-length quest in its own right, or settle for something much and have optional reading.

In the back of the **Journal** is a small metallic trinket, and the last page mentions that the writer is grateful they were able to seal away the "truly dangerous ones". Hopefully keeping the key parts separate assures that they're locked away for good.



Runite Trinket

Each variant of **Metal Dragon** houses a metal trinket matching their type, which you can now receive as a potential secondary drop at a 1/50 rate. They are untradable and you can only have one.

Possibly have to be obtained in order, similar to **Deposits**? Or any order.

Once all 6 trinkets are obtained, they can be used to open the sealed door leading to **Rune Dragons**.

I believe **Rune Dragons** should be located somewhere on **Zeah**, however without all of **Zeah** being released yet, the location is more or less open to discussion. I believe in the north is suitable, or perhaps near the planned volcano. We have loads of options, and with **Zeah** the lore potential is wide open.

It's also possible that **Rune Dragons** could tie in with the upcoming **Raid**s, either unlocking their area via **Raid**s or killing them. Really depends on how flexible the team's current plans and schedule are.

If you want to collect certain materials and don't know where to look, check the Battlefield-Specific Materials first before you take on the quest. Before starting the battle, cook some food that increases the material drop rate such as the Egg Pudding, Egg Tart, Wildberry Crepe. Farming for a large number of these materials increases the likelihood of receiving more reports at the end of a battle. This will boost the chances of obtaining at least 10 pieces of the reports per battle. We recommend cooking food that increases the material drop rate such as the Egg Pudding, Egg Tart, Wildberry Crepe and choosing a challenge with a large number of foes such as Chief-of-the-Dunes or Explosive—Handle with Care.
